Scale	Level of Understanding	Nature of Understanding in the Level for Promotion Testing
A	Knowledge	Remembering learned material; may involve the recall of a wide range of material from specific facts to complete theories, but merely requires bringing to mind the appropriate information
B	Comprehension	The ability to grasp the meaning of material; may be shown by translating material from one form to another; by interpreting material (explaining or summarizing).
C	Application	The ability to use learned materials in new and concrete situations; may include the application of such things as rules, methods, concepts, principles, laws, and theories.
D	Analysis	The ability to break down material into its component parts so that its organizational structure may be understood; may include the identification of the parts, analysis of the relationship between parts, and recognition of the organizational principles involved.
